And as a special added attraction this year, enjoy a free concert by the Folias Duo as they perform Classical, Jazz, Flamenco, and World Music on a variety of instruments including flute and guitar. Flutist Carmen Maret and guitarist Andrew Bergeron of the Folias Duo are a married couple whose unique interpersonal performer-composer collaboration of twenty years breathes new life into various musical genres. They meld European classical music with jazz, world music, and improvisation into their own rhythms, contours, and textures.

"We love updating the public on everything going on in our region," said David Read, YSAC Executive Director. "The performance by Folias Duo will be an extra added attraction," he added.
