Marysville, Calif., September 16, 2025 – "Art & Oysters" is back this year and promises to be even bigger and better than ever with more oysters, more music and more art. For the very first time, the location will be the Sutter Theater Center for the Arts, 754 Plumas Street in Yuba City. Tickets are \$85 each or \$650 for a table of eight. Tickets at the door, if available, will be \$95 each. Admission includes all you can eat oysters, chicken and side dishes. There will be a full no-host bar. Tickets are available online at yubasutterarts.org and in person at the Sutter Theater box office. There is limited seating so do not delay if you are planning to attend. The live music, comedy, art, fun atmosphere and great company are all included. Proceeds from the event will benefit the opening of the 299-seat Main Stage theater. By the way, naming rights for the theater are still available for purchase! Event sponsorships are also available from \$250 to \$1,500 with incremental benefits at each level.

So, what might one expect at an event titled "Art & Oysters" you ask? There will be multiple oyster stations where you can select from barbequed, "Rockefellered," or on the half-shell oysters without the long wait times. The oysters will include a selection of fine oysters from the north coast with a special selection of unique sauces and mignonettes. And for those who don't yet have their "oyster legs," chicken and a wonderful array of side dishes will be available. "He was a bold man that first ate an oyster," or so said author Jonathan Swift who wrote "Gulliver's Travels." No boldness will be required at Art & Oysters.

Live music will be provided by a variety of local performers with a selection of original songs and covers of popular music. And what about the "art" in Art & Oysters? The evening will feature an artists' showcase and lots of great silent auction items will be offered at very affordable starting prices including, well some oyster arts and crafts. There will be hand-painted oyster holiday ornaments in addition to oyster wreaths, oyster lamps, oyster candleholders and other custom oyster-inspired creations.

Come support a great seasonal community event with a special twist. And remember, just like in the "Oyster and the Carpenter" by Lewis Carroll, "O Oysters,' said the Carpenter, you've had a pleasant run! Shall we be trotting home again?
